Re: Resolution regarding use of Round Up by the Department of Recreation and Parks

At a recent public meeting of the Coastal San Pedro Neighborhood Council, the following resolution was passed by the Board of Directors:

Whereas Roundup has been discussed as a possible carcinogen and Bayer has already paid \$10B in legal settlements related to Roundup,

Be It Resolved, the Coastal San Pedro Neighborhood Council urges the Department of Recreation and Parks to explore and implement safer alternative methods for vegetation control than Roundup (glyphosate), and

Be It Further Resolved, the Coastal San Pedro Neighborhood Council requests the Department of Recreation and Parks to post notification as to when a particular park unit will be treated with Roundup.
